It is strictly prohibited to make any holes in the surface of the Service Park or any designated competition areas. Any breach of this regulation will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course, who may impose a financial penalty up to €3,000.

Transport platforms or trailers may only be parked in the designated area adjacent to the Service Park, as marked by the Organiser. Any breach of this regulation will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course, who may impose a financial penalty of up to €1,000.

Serious or repeated infringements may be reported to the Stewards for further action.

5.1. SERVICE PARK RULES

a) Maximum speed

Maximum speed inside the Service Park is limited by **30 km/h.**

b) Tidiness

All crews are obliged to use a liquid-proof tarp under competition cars. Drilling or any other damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided. Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service Zone allocated to them. The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition.

The crews are responsible for the removal of their waste and sewage by dispensing them accordingly with their nature and by following Environmental Protocol. After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a financial penalty of 500 Euro applied by the Clerk of the Course.

c) Facilities

All FIA ERC registered drivers will have access to:

- Running water
- The following services will be available for all Competitors:
- General lighting
- General Security
- Public toilets
- Garbage containers and waste collection

- WC
- Electricity
- WLAN
- Fork-lift & Car transport -extra rental
- Exclusive security service for the team – extra service

Teams requiring these services are requested to send them by E-mail to Organiser.

d) Security and medical services

The service park will have a permanent security surveillance starting from Tuesday, 14th April 2026. Exclusive security service for the team can be hired through the Organisers.

A Medical Centre will be established at the service park.

7. FUEL

7.1. FUEL REGULATIONS

Fuel must be in compliance with FIA 2026 Appendix J, 252.9.

7.2. REFUELLING

Crews may refuel only in the designated refuelling areas mentioned in the road book, see below:

- Refuel Area of Service Park on Friday 17th April 2026 from 8:15 to 14:30.
- Refuel Area of Service Park on Saturday 18th April 2026 and Sunday 19th April 2026 marked in Roadbook and listed in Rally Itinerary
- Remote Refuel Areas on Saturday 18th April 2026 and Sunday 19th April 2026 marked in Roadbook and listed in Rally Itinerary

7.3. REFUELLING PROCEDURE

The crews and all refuelling personnel must comply with RRSR articles 61.2.3 – “In order to access the RA, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava” - and 61.2.7 – “It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling”.

The maximum number of mechanics authorised to help for the refuelling procedure must be two (2). These mechanics are requested to be duly identified with the accreditations that will be issued by the Organisers.

7.4. FUEL FOR ERC1 COMPETITORS

The information will be issued in a bulletin.

7.5. FUEL AUTONOMY

All cars must carry sufficient quantity of fuel to cope with all distances published in Rally Itinearary.

8. IMPORT OF VEHICLES AND SPARE PARTS

Competitors who are planning to bring rally cars or spare parts into Spain should be aware of applicable customs and tax regulations.

- From EU countries: No customs duties apply. VAT is handled according to EU intra-community supply rules. Vehicles are typically transported on trailers, as rally cars are often not road-legal.
- From non-EU countries: A formal customs declaration is required, together with an EORI number, commercial invoice, and transport documents. Import VAT (currently 21% in Spain) and possible customs duties may apply depending on tariff classification.
- Temporary importation: For cars and equipment used only during the event, temporary admission or an ATA Carnet is strongly recommended to avoid full duties and taxes.
- Spare parts: All parts must be correctly classified under HS/TARIC codes and declared at true commercial value. Motorsport components may be subject to closer inspection.
- Customs authority: Spanish customs procedures are managed by Agencia Tributaria.

Customs agents: The organizer strongly advises using a licensed customs broker experienced in motorsport logistics to ensure timely clearance.

9. HELICOPTERS

According with the FIA Safety Regulations and the Civil Aviation authorities, all helicopters in the rally area be registered with the Organiser. The registration form must be submitted before **24 March 2026**.

The registration fee to the organiser for each helicopter is **€3.000 + 21% VAT**. A compulsory helicopter pilots briefing will be held on Tuesday 16 April in Rally HQ.

All pilots must be in possession of a valid professional pilot licence Without prior approval from the organiser, it is strictly forbidden to use any ground-controlled flying devices (drones)

10. HOSPITALITY ARRANGEMENTS

12. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance will be according to FIA RRSR Art. 35. The schedule for the reconnaissance is published in Appendix 2 of these Rally Guide. Reconnaissance will be limited to a maximum of two (2) passages per Special Stage, even if it is run twice during the rally, at a reduced speed (see art. 9.2 of Sup. Reg.)

and fully respecting the Road Traffic Laws in Spain. It is allowed to make video of the SS during the reconnaissance.

12.1. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Reconnaissance must be done with cars according to Art. 35 of 2026 FIA Regional Rallies Championships Sporting Regulations.

Organisers will give a reconnaissance vehicle identification sticker together with the reconnaissance documentation to all entrants on Wednesday 15th April, from 09:00 to 15:00 hrs. (as specified in the Time Program - art. 3 of these Sup. Reg.)

Reconnaissance's sticker must be affixed during reconnaissance on the top right of the front windscreen.

The presence of drivers and/or co-drivers on a special stage, in any way whatsoever will be considered as reconnaissance.

It is allowed to film the SS during the reconnaissance.

12.2. SPECIFIC AND/OR NATIONAL RESTRICTIONS - SPEED LIMIT ON THE SS

During reconnaissance, all national traffic regulation must be followed, including but not limited to the speed limits. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organizer may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Speeding during reconnaissance and / or shakedown will be penalised according to FIA RRSR Article 34.2.

The maximum speed during reconnaissance of special stages is fixed at 80 km/h except where there are speed limit signs.

Speeding during reconnaissance will incur a fine applied by the Clerk of the Course as follows:

25 € Per km per hour over the speed limit (all drivers)

It is emphasised that reconnaissance is not practice. All the Road Traffic Laws in Spain must be strictly adhered to and the safety and rights of the other road users must be respected.

Reconnaissance vehicles must be covered by the insurance demanded by current legislation, the Organizers will bear no responsibility.

12.3. TRACKING SYSTEM FOR RECONNAISSANCE

All competitors must be equipped for reconnaissance with a smartphone-based application RS Lite system provided by the FIA official supplier STATUS AWARENESS SYSTEM (SAS).

The free app is available on the Google Play and Apple App store. Competitors are responsible for having a device capable of using the app with GPS tracking and a battery lasting the entirety of recce. Considerations should be made to make sure the phone or tablet can be charged and there are no 1st party applications that may disable GPS tracking.

SAS will distribute individual event access codes during the reconnaissance registration.

13. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

13.1. SCRUTINEERING, VENUE AND TIMETABLE

Venue	Esplanade adjacent to the service park
Date and time	Thursday 16th April from 08:30 to 19:00 (as per individual time published in a Bulletin).

The car must arrive to the scrutineering with the rally plates, competition numbers, optional advertising affixed. Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the Team.

13.1.1 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

Competitor must show the car's complete certified homologation documents:

- Scrutineering card
- Vehicle FIA technical passport, when it's applicable
- Vehicle ASN technical passport, when it's applicable
- Vehicle original FIA homologation form
- The installation of the tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.

13.1.2 Sealing and Marking

Car's chassis and engine will be marked as prescribed in Art. 31.1 of the 2026 FIA RR Sporting Regulations. Sealing of the cars' mechanical components (fitted on the cars and spares) will be carried out according to the 2026 FIA RR Sporting Regulations, Art. 16.

All cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials; these parts must be kept in the car for the weighing procedure. Cars and mechanical components must be provided with holes for sealing.

After pre-rally Scrutineering, any change of sealed component must be notified by the competitor to the following email: erc-technical@fia.com. This notification must be received prior the part change.

13.2. MUD FLAPS

Fitting and use of mud flaps, comply with Art. 252.7.7 of FIA Appendix J, is permitted but not compulsory.

13.3. WINDOWS

The use of transparent and colorless anti-shatter films (maximum thickness: 100 microns) is compulsory on side and sunroof windows, unless they are in polycarbonate (see Art. 253.11 of FIA Appendix J).

Rear side and sunroof windows may use silvered or tinted films (see conditions below) in replacement of transparent and colorless anti-shatter films.

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorized, on the rear side windows, on the rear window and on the sunroof, on the following conditions:

Silvered or tinted films fitted on rear side windows must have an opening equivalent to the surface of a circle of 70 mm in diameter so that the driver as well as the contents of the car may be seen from the outside.

13.4. DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Competitors must present all the items of protective clothing, which will be used including underwear, helmets and FIA approved head restraint (FHR system, formerly called HANS) and filled safety equipment documents. Compliance will be checked with Appendix L Chapter III and with technical regulations. See Appendix 5 of these Supplementary regulations.

13.5. NOISE LEVEL

At any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with FIA Appendix J.

13.6. SPECIAL NATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Competing cars must be equipped with:

Vehicles registered abroad: reflective triangles.

Vehicles registered in spain: V16 beacon

One red "SOS" sign and on the reverse a green "OK" sign measuring at least 42 x 29,7 cm (A/3 size).

Two fluorescent jackets (one per each member of the crew).

13.7. INSTALLATION OF THE SAFETY TRACKING SYSTEM

All competitors must make provisions in their rally cars for the installation of the FIA Safety Emergency Console System, and the system must be installed before the car is brought to scrutineering.

For installation and operating instructions see Appendix 7.

Tracking Systems may be collected either by the crew or a representative.

No deposit will be collected for the rally safety tracking equipment, but all the damage caused will be invoiced afterwards.

The FIA Safety Emergency Console System devices must be removed in the final Parc Fermé by the crew or a team member under the supervision of a scrutineer and must be returned no later than 22:00 h. on Sunday 19th April 2026 to **STATUS AWARNESS SYSTEM (SAS)** at the Service Park. Should a crew retire, the equipment must be returned immediately to SAS.

All drivers and co-drivers must complete before the Administrative Checks the FIA eLearning Course and pass the assessment for the FIA Safety Tracking device. The assessment is available on the website <https://elearning.fia.com/learn/register> in English and French. Instructions for completing the course will be sent to all entered crews by e-mail after the entry closing date.

The crew must present at the Administrative Checks the Certificate of having completed the above-mentioned Course.

13.8. ON-BOARD CAMERA

Competitors wishing to use an on-board camera must apply via the ERC Accreditation Portal at least one week before the start of reconnaissance.

20.1. CORDOBA

Córdoba is a city located in the autonomous community of Andalusia in southern Spain and serves as the capital of the Province of Córdoba. With a population of approximately 324,900 inhabitants as of 2024, it is the 12th-largest city in Spain and the third-largest city in Andalusia.

The city lies primarily on the right bank of the Guadalquivir River in the southern part of the Iberian Peninsula. Córdoba has a long and complex history: it was originally a Roman colony, later controlled by the Visigothic Kingdom in the sixth century, and conquered by Muslim forces in the eighth century.

Under Islamic rule, Córdoba became the capital of the Emirate and later the Caliphate of Córdoba, governed by the Umayyad dynasty. During the 10th century, the city developed into one of the most important cultural, scientific, and educational centres in Europe and is considered to have been the second-largest city on the continent at that time. Political instability in the early 11th century led to the collapse of the caliphate.

Following its Christian reconquest in 1236, Córdoba was incorporated into the Crown of Castile and became the head of the Kingdom of Córdoba. Today, the city's historic legacy is reflected in its exceptional architectural and cultural heritage.

Córdoba is internationally renowned for its Moorish architecture, particularly the Mezquita-Cathedral, which was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984. The designation was later extended to include the entire historic centre of the city. The nearby archaeological site of Madinat al-Zahra is also recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, while the Festival of the Patios has been inscribed as UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage.

20.2. CLIMATE CORDOBA

Córdoba has a continental Mediterranean climate with Atlantic influences. Winters are generally mild, although occasional frosts may occur due to the city's inland location. Summers are extremely hot, with significant daily temperature fluctuations. Maximum temperatures are among the highest in Europe, frequently exceeding 40°C and on some occasions surpassing 45°C. The average temperature in July and August is around 28°C. Rainfall is concentrated mainly in the colder months due to Atlantic weather

systems, with annual precipitation reaching approximately 600 mm and showing considerable year-to-year variability.

20.3. TIME ZONE

Spain operates in the Central European Time zone (CET, GMT+1). From the last Sunday in March to the last Sunday in October, daylight saving time (Central European Summer Time – CEST, GMT+2) is applied.
